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FUTURE FORMS SOLUTIONS

Exercise 1: Fill-in-the-Blank

(Sample correct answers – note that both “will” and “am/are going to” can be acceptable depending on context; here are suggested answers)

1. Tomorrow, I **am going to visit** my grandparents.
 2. Next week, she **is going to call** her best friend.
 3. Tonight, they **are going to order** sushi for dinner.
 4. We **are going to travel** to Rome next month.
 5. He **will start** his new job on Monday.
 6. You **are going to help** me with the homework later.
 7. I **am going to buy** a new laptop soon.
 8. Look at those clouds – it **is going to rain** this afternoon.
 9. They **will play** football at the park tomorrow.
 10. She **will study** for her exam next week.
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Exercise 2: Compose the Sentence

(One acceptable reordering for each)

1. Correct Sentence: **I will visit my grandparents next week.**
(Jumbled version: “I will visit next week my grandparents.”)
2. Correct Sentence: **She is going to call her best friend tomorrow.**
(Jumbled version: “She is going to her best friend call tomorrow.”)
3. Correct Sentence: **They are going to order sushi for dinner tonight.**
(Jumbled version: “They order tonight are going to sushi for dinner.”)
4. Correct Sentence: **We are going to travel to Rome next month.**
(Jumbled version: “We to Rome are going to travel next month.”)
5. Correct Sentence: **He will start his new job on Monday.**
(Jumbled version: “He will start on Monday his new job.”)

6. Correct Sentence: **You are going to help me with the homework later.**
(Jumbled version: "You help are going to me with the homework later.")

(Jumbled version: "They will play tomorrow football at the park.")

(Jumbled version: "She next week study will for her exam.")
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Exercise 3: Find the Error

(Corrections)

1. **Error:** I going to visit my grandparents tomorrow.
Correction: I **am going to visit** my grandparents tomorrow.
2. **Error:** She call her best friend tomorrow.
Correction: She **will call** her best friend tomorrow.
(Or "is going to call," if intended as a planned action.)
3. **Error:** They order pizza for dinner tonight.
Correction: They **are going to order** pizza for dinner tonight.
4. **Error:** We travel to Rome next month.
Correction: We **are going to travel** to Rome next month.
5. **Error:** He start his new job on Monday.
Correction: He **will start** his new job on Monday.

6. **Error:** You are help me with the homework later.
Correction: You **are going to help** me with the homework later.
 7. **Error:** I buy a new laptop soon.
Correction: I **will buy** a new laptop soon.
(Or “am going to buy” if planned.)
 8. **Error:** It rain this afternoon.
Correction: It **is going to rain** this afternoon.
 9. **Error:** They play football at the park tomorrow.
Correction: They **will play** football at the park tomorrow.
 10. **Error:** She study for her exam next week.
Correction: She **will study** for her exam next week.

(Alternatively: "It is going to rain soon.")
